INFORMATION

- 1) Riverbend High School has registered four teams: 1 Latin I, 2 Latin IIs, and 1 Upper Level. We have space for other students to serve as alternates, fillers, spotters, or scorers who also wish to participate in the other Classics Day activities.
- 2) The format of the certamen may be modified due to time constraints. Last year, each round, including the final round, had 15 toss-up questions with one bonus. The questions will be based on the syllabus of the National Latin Exam. Question formats will be typical of those used at NJCL-sponsored tournaments. Students participating in the final round of certamen will miss some of the other scheduled activities.
- 3) We will be sharing a bus with other teams from Spotsylvania County in order to conserve resources and split the costs. We are departing from and returning to Courtland because it is centrally located in the county.
- 4) \*\*All students should bring a lunch, snacks, and beverages with them. There is a very limited amount of time scheduled for lunch and the boxed lunches they would have us order were too expensive. Unfortunately, there will not be time or opportunity to go to "The Corner" for lunch or shopping.
- 5) \*\*\*The activities after lunch consist of three rotations: a Roman game, a "college style lecture," and a classical tour of the Lawn.
